#### 47,000+ members

As of March 26, 2020:

- 48.13% COPD Patients
- 12.67% Family or Friends
- 7.17% Caregivers
- 32.02% Medical Affiliate/Healthcare Professional



#### COVID-19 Survey #1





- Online, anonymized global survey created with input from international medical and scientific experts
- Promoted on:
  - COPD360social
  - BronchandNTM360social
- Live from March 29<sup>th</sup> to April 13<sup>th</sup>
- 566 survey respondents total
- Used 'machine learning' to analyze comments\*

# 513 Respondents with COPD

- 80 with bronchiectasis
- 11 with NTM lung disease
- 16 with bronchiectasis and NTM lung disease
- 225 supplemental oxygen users
- 177 experienced exacerbation(s) in 2020

# 46 Respondents without COPD

- 2 with bronchiectasis
- 1 with NTM lung disease
- 12 caregivers
- 18 healthcare providers

#### **COVID-19 Hospitalizations & Symptoms**

### 16 diagnosed (by healthcare professional) with COVID-19

- 6 tested for COVID-19
  - 2 **positive** COVID-19, and both hospitalized for longer than 1 week
    - 1 in ICU for longer than 1 week


## Results consistent with other data on COVID-19:

- Incidence of COVID-19 is not higher in people with COPD, but the outcome (hospitalization) is worse.
- COVID-19 testing is underutilized in this at-risk population.

#### Summary: Learnings from COPD360 COVID-19 Survey #1



- Results consistent with emerging COVID-19 data:
  - Incidence of COVID-19 is not higher in people with COPD, but the outcome (hospitalization) is worse
  - COVID-19 testing is underutilized in the COPD population
- COPD360social community members are anxious and fearful
- Medications data will be helpful in the planning of future research
- Community needs continued support throughout this pandemic



#### Looking Ahead... COPD360social COVID-19 Survey #2

- Repeating questions from survey #1
- Adding new questions about:
  - New Demographics questions
    - Country
    - City vs. rural area
    - Diagnosis of Alpha-1 Antitrypsin Deficiency
  - Daily routine changes during the pandemic
  - Feedback on what community members want assistance with during this pandemic
  - Assessing recovery/hospital discharge (for those who tested positive for COVID-19)
